Travel to SWG3

International Assembly takes place at SWG3, 100 Eastvale Place, G3 8QG in Glasgow which is:

- By foot 40 minute walk from the city centre
- By train/subway the nearest subway station is Kelvinhall, and the nearest train station is Partick, both a 10-15 walk from the venue
- By car metered street parking is available on Eastvale Place and Kelvinhaugh Street
- By taxi the following are local companies who regularly pick up and drop off at the venue

ID may be required to buy alcohol. SWG3 (the venue) is a short walk to a Glasgow area called 'Finnieston' which has lots of good cafes, restaurants, supermarkets if you need anything else.
